NARRATIVE:


a. At approximately 1737 hours on Thursday, August 13th 2009, CSI Jenny Welch, #4410, Forensic Unit, met with Sergeant John Allen, #1804, Missing Persons Unit, and Detective Yuri Melich, #2684, Homicide Unit, at the Orange County Department of Corrections (jail), located at 3471 Vision Boulevard. This Investigator was requested to respond to the Orange County Department of Corrections to photograph a tattoo that suspect, Casey Anthony, had on her back. The photographs were taken under a Court Order.

b. This Investigator, Sgt. Allen, and Det. Melich then met with an attorney from the Baez Law Firm at the Orange County Department of Corrections, and all then responded to the Women's Detention Center at the jail.

- c. An office area of a room in the Women's Detention Center was utilized for the photographs in order to provide privacy due to the suspect, Casey Anthony, having to lift up her shirt for the photographs of her tattoo to be taken. Along with this Investigator, a corrections officer, Det. Melich, and the Baez Law Firm attorney were present in the room with suspect, Casey Anthony.
- d. Prior to taking photographs, this Investigator advised suspect, Casey Anthony, that overall photographs would first be taken and then photographs of the tattoo would be taken. This Investigator first took overall photographs of the suspect before clothing was moved. Once overalls were taken, the suspect then lifted up her shirt to reveal the tattoo. This Investigator took photographs of the tattoo without a scale. This Investigator then advised the suspect that a sticker scale would be placed on her to take additional photographs. Before the sticker scale was removed and moved to another angle, this Investigator informed the suspect what would be done.
- e. Once photographs were complete, Det. Melich advised that nothing further was needed from this Investigator. The following observations were made.

OBSERVATIONS:

- a. A tattoo of "Bella Vita" was observed to be located on the left shoulder blade area of the suspect's back.

PHOTOGRAPHS:

- a. A series of - 23 - digital photographs were taken that consisted of identification photographs of the suspect, including overalls and close-up photographs of the suspect's tattoo, without and with a sticker "L" scale. The photographs also included photographs of the suspect's Orange County Corrections identification card.

REMARKS:

- a. The digital flashcard has been uploaded onto the Orange County Sheriff's Office DataWorks Plus system by this Investigator.
